Christian Lloyd Lindman, 49, of NE Minneapolis, died at Hennepin County Medical Center on December 27th, 2022 after suffering a cardiac arrest at his home. Christian was born March 8th, 1973 in Rochester, Minnesota to Robert (Bob) and Judith (Judy) Lindman.
