Curry, Christopher James Allan was born on September 22, 1964 in Minneapolis. He died tragically on May 11, 2014, at age 49, of a heart attack at South Beach on Lake Harriet while running. He was dearly loved and will be profoundly missed. He is preceded in death by father, Sheldon James Curry, and is survived by his wife, Catherine Curry; three beloved children: Aidan (12), Rowan (11), and Bronach (9); mother, Marianne Curry; sisters, Dr. Dana Lynne Curry and Shelley Curry O'Neill; many nieces and nephews; and scores of amazing friends. Chris attended grades 1-8 in Lakeville, and graduated from Breck School in 1983. He was conferred the highest Boy Scout award of Eagle Scout and Order of the Arrow. He studied abroad in Switzerland in 1984; he graduated from University of MN, Phi Beta Kappa, in 1988; he also graduated from William Mitchell College of Law, his father and grandfather's alma mater, in 1992, summa cum laude; he also graduated magna cum laude with an MBA from the Carlson School of Management (UMN) in 2014. Chris was employed as Vice President and General Counsel at Gage Marketing in Plymouth. Above all, Chris was a devoted husband, and a rock-star father to his three dearly-loved children, who were the center of his life. He was a loving son and brother, as well as mentor to his vast network of friends and colleagues who were an extension of his family. He gained strength from his community at Mt. Olivet Lutheran Church. His love of nature and scouting earned him the affectionate title: Nature Boy. Funeral services will be held at 1:00 pm on Friday, May 16, with a reception following the

service at Mount Olivet Lutheran Church, located at 5025 Knox Avenue S., Minneapolis, MN, 55419; Pastor Monica Hammersten will officiate. A private interment will follow at Lakewood Cemetery.
