Christopher Thomas Rheineck, lover of his family, his friends, the Vikings, classic Rhythm & Blues, basketball, barbecued ribs, lox & bagels, hugs and his Lord, God, died of accidental causes on June 13, 2021, at the age of 34.

Chris was born in Waukesha, WI and is the middle child of Thomas Rheineck and Elizabeth Nelson. He had an older sister, Elisa, who passed away at age 11 in 1997 and they were inseparable as kids.
