Aronson, Claire Susan (b. 1929), died on March 22, 2021, at Sunrise of Edina Senior Living. Claire lived an active life with many interests. Until dementia took her pastimes from her, she was a member of the Weavers Guild of Minnesota, a published poet, an avid reader, and an adventurous traveler. She worked as a freelance editor and writer, and served as publisher of the Prospect Park newsletter *The Riverbank Rambler*.
