Clarence was also the visionary behind a groundbreaking 302-bedroom healthcare system project currently underway in Careysburg, Liberia. This is an initiative that reflects his lifelong passion for creating access, opportunity, and healing. As the founder of MAC Global, a construction company operating in Liberia, he continued to build not only structures, but legacy.

Above all his accomplishments, Clarence's greatest joy was his family. He was a devoted husband, loving father, caring son, supportive brother, dependable uncle, and loyal friend.
