“ I didn't know Clark well, but he was a staple of MN agility. Since I was 9, Clark was at literally every trial I have ever been in. He was always volunteering, dropping hilarious comments, and pointing out good things about every run, especially for beginners. I want to share a few memories I have of Clark. I normally would've written this in a card, but feel posting it here is safer. Bear with me as this is a little long.

1. I was in Excellence with my first dog, black miniature poodle Shadow, and was frustrated because he hated agility and would walk the whole course, and so we kept exceeding the course time and therefore wouldn't qualify even though we did everything correctly. After one very slow course, I stomped out of the ring with Shadow (I was 13) and Clark said, "You know, that dog never puts a foot out of place. He always does everything perfect." It was a gentle reminder that Shadow was a good dog even if he wasn't fast.

2. My current dog, brown miniature poodle Willy, and I were in novice, struggling to connect on course. At the end of a 3-day show with qualifying rounds, we had our 6th and final run. All the upper level people had left and there was nobody to video our run. Clark was of course still there scribing. He saw me searching and said that he would do it. I replied that he couldn't possibly video in addition to scribing for us because we had made many mistakes that weekend and were bound to make many more that he'd have to write down. Clark looked at Willy and smiled, and Willy wagged his tail. Clark said, "I don't think you're going to have any faults this run. Give me the camera." I don't know what he did, but that was the first run where we made no mistakes. (I'm still searching for the video because Clark had some great commentary!) After that day, Willy always gave Clark a sneaky lick on the leg as we walked by at shows.

3. Willy and I were running our first Open Jumpers course with just one mistake on the weaves and were sprinting through the last jumps. Willy was still very green and he ran around the last jump, making our second mistake so we wouldn't qualify. The crowd audibly groaned but I threw my hands up in the air all excited and called his name in a high-pitched voice so he would come back and

do the last jump. After we left the ring, Clark said to me as we walked by, "Nobody else stays that positive when their dog makes a mistake, it's so fun to watch!" and that made me feel like I was the best agility handler in the world.

Clark will be sorely missed by the agility community. Sending love and prayers to all his family and friends in this terrible time. <3
