Age 81 of Lino Lakes, Minnesota passed away on April 10, 2023

Clifford, known as Cliff or Junior, to family and friends was born June 8, 1941 in Minneapolis, Minnesota to Clifford E. White Sr. and Anne M. White (Hess). He graduated from Golden Valley High School in 1959. He earned his Bachelor of Science from Saint Cloud State College.
