St. Paul - of St. Paul died on Aug. 28, 2025, at age 89. Born in Minneapolis in July 1936, the Roosevelt High School graduate worked 44 years in newspaper production at the St. Paul Pioneer Press. From 1954-61 he sailed on annual tours with the Naval Reserve. Conrad was a beloved older brother to sisters Carole J. Wilson (partner, Richard Fata), of Arizona, who spent his last weeks with him; and Marilyn Berg Cooper, of California; and their late husbands, David Wilson and Gary Cooper. He was a cherished uncle to Marc Wilson (wife Stacey, son Connor; stepchildren Kylie, Chase and Khloe), of Arizona; and Rebecca Mühlethaler (husband Grégoire, sons Xander and Fox), of Switzerland.
