



## Corson River Steinbach

May 14, 1998 - December 31, 2018

Steinbach, Corson River, age 20 of Mounds View, MN, succumbed to his overwhelming struggle with depression stemming from bipolar disorder.

Survived by his parents, Joerg and Carly; brother, Jasper; grandparents, Andrew & Joan Eisenzimmer and Hans-Joerg & Mary Steinbach; uncles, Justin Eisenzimmer, Darren Eisenzimmer (Nicole); aunt, Kristine Frost (Chris); great aunt, Ruth Nelson; cousins, London, Gretchen, Chace, Autumn, and Natalie. Also survived by best friends, Thanh Osancevic, Zach Becka, and Nick Mischke; and numerous other loving relatives and friends.

Since he was young, Corson loved skiing, biking, reading, computer gaming, good food, and laughing with friends. Corson graduated with honors from Irondale High School in 2016. He was an outstanding student and excelled in his studies. His senior year he was co-captain of the Alpine Ski Team, and was voted MVP by his teammates. Later he was so proud to be accepted into the University of Minnesota, where he began studying computer science. Corson was intelligent, humorous, and had an empathetic soul.

Corson courageously tried many forms of therapy and treatment to achieve wellness. He was in tremendous pain, but has found peace. In his exact words, "Please know I am in a better place now. Hopefully, I will be

remembered as the person I was, not the one I ended up being."
