“ I met Craig in Mr. Haley’s homeroom during our junior year at Southwest, which was the beginning of a lifelong friendship. We worked for a landscape company, detailed cars and double dated. After graduation I drove Craig to the railroad station when he went to boot camp at Great Lakes Naval Training Center. We kept in touch mainly by mail until he came back to Minneapolis to begin his new career. He asked me to be his Best Man when he married Roseann in Rockford Illinois. Six months later he was my Best Man in Minneapolis. In 1967 he helped us move out of our apartment and distribute the furnishings as we left for my Navy career. In 1969 when I was on my way to Viet Nam I was able to settle Jan and Carolyn in Edina and Craig drove me to the airport so Jan didn’t have to. When I came back we lived close by in Richfield until I was transferred to Pensacola again. I told Craig that I was never going to live where it snowed. We would visit family and friends in Minneapolis as often as possible over the ensuing years. In 1997 I began working in Dubuque Iowa and called Craig to ask his advice on what snowblower he recommended. He reminded me what I had said in 1971 and we both laughed. In the years that followed Craig and Roseann invited us to join them at Solbakken every September for a week of relaxation, food and hiking. I have so many fond memories of what we did together and am glad that there are no videos of some of our adventures. Namaste my friend.
