After high school, he attended business college, interrupting his education to serve in the United States Army. Curt had a successful career in sales, eventually managing his own company with partner Bob Blakely. Curt was a soft-spoken man, conservative in behavior, but generous with others. His friendships were enduring, and often life-long. He was preceded in death by his parents, as well as siblings Verna, Esther, Burton, and Carmen. He is survived by his wife, Lucille, sons Paul (Margy) and Joel, daughter Anne (Kevin), grandchildren Ilse, Christopher, Andrew, and Isabelle, sister Arliss Boyum, and many nieces and nephews.
