



Cynthia Faigle Quinn

August 8, 1933 - November 11, 2022

Quinn, Cynthia F. 89, of Vero Beach FL, formerly of Edina, MN passed away unexpectedly on November 11, 2022. Cynthia was born in New York City, graduated from Abbot Academy (Philips Andover) and Syracuse University where she was President of her sorority Chi Omega. She married the love of her life, Paul, 67 years ago. Together they lived in Morocco, Brazil, Mexico, New Jersey and Connecticut before moving to Minnesota in 1974. She and Paul moved to Vero Beach, FL in 1993 still spending their summers in Edina, MN. Survived by children Kenneth (Jessica), Bruce (Catherine), Leslie Connelly (Timothy) and Christopher (Rosanna), 11 grandchildren, 9 1/2 great-grandchildren, her sister Joan Hallenbeck (Alfred, d. 2017) and brother Gerald Faigle (Roberta). Family was the main interest of her life, and she organized unforgettable family reunions every 2 years including adventures in Hawaii, Mexico, Alaska and Northern Minnesota among other destinations. Cynthia's positivity manifested itself when, as a cancer survivor in 1991, she imparted her experiences as a mentor to other cancer victims. Her organizational skills were remarkable and included book clubs, bridge and 9-hole golf outings. An accomplished artist (oils and watercolor), she displayed and sold her art in several exhibitions in Minnesota and Florida. She will be sorely missed by family and friends, many of whom gathered by her side to bid her farewell during her final days at the hospital. A memorial gathering will be held on Monday November 14th at Washburn-McReavy Edina Chapel, 5000 West 50th Street, Edina, MN from 4-6pm followed by a celebration of life to be held
