



## Dagmar (Soneson) Larsen

Larsen, Dagmar (Soneson), 90, died peacefully, surrounded by her children May 28, 2018 in Golden Valley, MN. Born June 2, 1927, she is preceded in death by her parents, Florence and Oliver Olson, her sister Bethia Neubauer, her first husband, J. Melburn Soneson, and second husband Ted (T.E.) Larsen. Learning to play the organ at a young age, she served as organist at Grace Baptist Church in Minneapolis, Edgewater Covenant Church in Chicago, and Franklin Park United Church of Christ. Her lengthiest position as organist at North Park Covenant Church in Chicago from 1973-1993 saw the introduction of a new pipe organ in the sanctuary. At North Park she also directed children's choirs and introduced handbells to the worship service, organizing and directing several handbell choirs. She attended Bethel College in St. Paul, earning an associate degree in 1947 and nearly thirty years later she returned to college to earn a Bachelor of Music degree in organ performance in 1976. Dagmar is survived by her children Jerry Soneson, Dan Soneson (Carol Skalko), Karen Coss, and Janet Brook (Andy), grandchildren Per Soneson (Anna), Björn Soneson (Lia), Sara Anderson (Ben), Megan Brook and Ryan Brook, great grandson Nils Soneson, and by brother Warren (Rita) Olson. Upon marrying Ted Larsen, their families merged to include Ted's children Richard Larsen (Daryl), Doug Larsen(Linda), and Nancy Hayes and grandchildren, Bryce Larsen (Kelly), Trent Larsen (Elizabeth), Andy Hayes (Jenny), and Zach Hayes (Jessica), as well as great-grandchildren J.T. and Hailey Larsen, and Holden, Marley, Daphne, and Otis Larsen. A memorial
