Dale Ingvar Carlson was born December 20, 1949, and passed away Thursday, December 23, 2021, at the age of 72.

Dale was born and raised in NE Minneapolis, graduating from Edison High School in 1967. Dale was a kind, loving husband, father, brother and grandfather, and enjoyed being surrounded by his family and friends. Dale especially loved taking his daughters on cross country motorcycle trips with his brother, Ken. This past year he started riding again with his new Harley. He

was also an avid bicyclist riding his bike several miles a day plus the bike trails in Pequot, MN. He told many stories of growing up with his brothers and sisters, raising his daughters, snowmobiling, pulling family and friends water skiing, and training his German Shepard dogs. He enjoyed many years up north at our condo, Channel Heights and our lake home in Crosslake pulling grandkids on Big Mabel, spending time with family and our up north friends. Dale enjoyed walking around our Sunset lake home neighborhood, cruising the lake and watching sunsets. He loved to travel, especially cruises, listening to music and dancing plus spending winter months in Florida. The memories he gave us are a blessing.

Dale was a member of North Heights Lutheran church and ushered for 27 years. Dale's faith provided him comfort and assurance during his life, especially as his health declined. Dale and Twana met at North Heights single group and were blessed with 13 years of marriage and 16 years of love, creating many precious memories. We had many family gatherings enjoying our children, grandkids, family and friends at our home.

Dale retired in 2016 from Washburn McReavy, Hillside Cemetery after 47 years of service in the funeral business. He started working at Hillside Cemetery with the grounds crew in 1967 at the age of 18, became foreman in 1971 and assistant superintendent in 1979, becoming superintendent in 1981. In 2001 he became Director of Cemetery Operations for Washburn McReavy managing four cemeteries until his retirement. Dale was dedicated to his work, managing the cemetery staff, planning Memorial Day, Christmas Remembrance ceremonies and providing service and comfort to grieving families. Dale always put the families he served first and ensured they were treated with compassion and great respect. Dale loved his job and the people he worked with, plus being a mentor to several.

Dale was a 39 year member of Minnesota Association of Cemeteries,

presiding as President 1989-1990. Dale was also a member of The Twin Cities Cemetery Association, President 2011 & 2012 plus serving as Ex Officio Director 1991 & 1992.

A Celebration of Life Service for Dale will be Sat. May 7, 2022, at Roseville North Heights Lutheran Church, 2701 Rice St, Roseville, MN 55113. The visitation starts at 10 AM, service at 11 AM with a luncheon to follow. Dale will have a private family interment at Hillside Cemetery where he spent so much of his life.

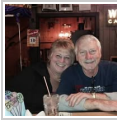
