Sprague Dale Arthur, died on Thursday, Feb. 3, 2005. He was born to Stanley and Georgia Sprague on September 21, 1915 in Madelia, MN. He attended public school in Madelia, graduating from high school in 1933. In 1937 he enrolled at the University of Minnesota. In 1941 he was commissioned an Army Reserve Officer and joined the United States Army serving in the United States and Europe during WWII for 4-1/2 years. Dale married Jeannette Hagestande on June 9, 1942. Following his discharge from the Army in 1946, Dale returned to the U of M to complete his degree in business administration, graduating in June 1946. He was employed by Investors Diversified Services for 33 years, retiring in 1979. He and Jeannette made their home in St. Louis Park, MN for 44 years before moving to 7500 York Cooperative in 1989 where he served on the Board of Directors for 7 years. Dale and Jeannette have been active members of Lutheran Church of the Good Shepherd since 1947. Survivors include his wife; 4 children, Patricia (Stephen) Cina, Julianne (Richard) Omland, James (Judy) and Gary (Pam); 9 grandchildren; 11 great-grandchildren; a sister, Jean (Donald) Hall; many nieces and nephews.
