Dale's obituary:

Dale Warren Wilson, age 79, of Minnetrista, Minnesota, passed away peacefully on October 1, 2025, holding the hand of his beloved wife of 23 years, Dar. Dale absolutely loved life and lived it to the fullest. He was an avid fisherman, a wonderful cook, a patriot, a born salesman, and a dog lover.
