Daniel George Ewings, age 59, passed away on December 8, 2023, surrounded by family and loved ones, after suffering a stroke. He is preceded in death by his parents, Jo and Gary Ewings, and Larry Wieczorek; grandparents, Mary (Dan) Baures and Joe Dureske, Lilla and Milton Ewings; nephew, Joshua Danielson.

He changed his work schedule by going into the office at 6 AM, so he wouldn't miss a single 4:00 PM game. Dan loved nothing more than seeing his three boys happy, healthy, and successful throughout all stages of their lives. Being a dad was his most treasured gift and something he truly never took for granted.

Beyond being an attentive father and loving husband, Dan found joy in many of the simple things in life. He and Kim built a life together enjoying incredible lasting friendships. He could be vacationing on a beach in the most breathtaking tropical paradise or sitting around their kitchen table in Lino Lakes, the location didn't matter, it was who he was with that mattered. He was happy if he was surrounded by Kim, his amazing friends, and all the people who meant the most to him. He took pride in his lawn - a fallen leaf on the ground was not his friend, as many of you know! He loved to cook. His passion for the Vikings, the Twins, and Timberwolves never went unnoticed. He loved golfing with his friends and always looked forward to their annual golf trip. He also loved nothing more than being at home, in the space where he felt most comfortable snuggled up with his two puppies who loved him dearly, Louie and Miles. Oh, and going to bed early - nothing could beat that! He showed everyone how to make each day a blessing no matter how ordinary it may have been.

Dan will be remembered for not only being a devoted husband, exceptional

father, loving brother, and caring friend, but also for his patient heart, calm demeanor, and gentle soul to all who knew him. To know Dan was to love Dan.
