Daniel C. Murphy, age 70 of Casa Grande, AZ died unexpectedly Friday, December 16, 2022 from a heart attack in Fridley, MN.

Dan was born a fraternal twin on December 9, 1952 at St. Mary's Hospital in Minneapolis, MN. His educational accomplishments include a bachelor's of science and a RN degree. The first ten years of his career Dan worked in various hospitals across the twin cities. The remainder of his career was spent as a QRC nurse case manager.
