She walked to grade school at St. Peter's Lutheran School and graduated from Lakefield high school. She attended Mankato Beauty School where she met Duane Lewis on a blind dates in 1946. When she came down the stairs in a short dress Duane said, you are the girl I am marrying. They were married July 5th, 1947 at the St. Peter Lutheran Church where Darline was baptized and confirmed. They were married almost 50 years until Duane died April 20th, 1997. Their first home was in St. Louis Park with money borrowed from Duane's father. Duane was employed by US F & G Insurance and the family moved to Sioux Falls, Omaha, Cleveland and Burnsville, MN. When they moved to Burnsville Darline got her first car and worked for Welcome Wagon and several years at Burnsville High School. They opened Dars Hallmark Shop in Shakopee, MN. They worked together seven days a week and sold it tweny one years later when Duane became ill. After Duane passed in 1997 Darline sold the house and moved to 7500 York in Edina for 10+ years. As a young girl her parents
