



## Darold Allen Scofield

April 7, 1937 - March 6, 2025

Darold A. Scofield, formally of Golden Valley, MN, passed away on Thursday, March 6, 2025 at the age of 87. He was born on April 7, 1937, on his Great Grandparent's farm in West Rock near Pine City. His parents moved to Rush City where he graduated in 1955. After graduation, he was employed at Kirchberg Produce in Rush City and Scofield's Taven with his mom and dad. He was drafted into the Army in 1960 spending 18 month in the Panama Canal. In his 2 years he achieved the rank of Specialist 5 (Sgt), as head of the Radio Repair shop in the Headquarters Group. He also was issued a Good Conduct Medal.

After Honorary Discharge, he attended Chicago Vocational School of Drafting from 1962-1963 in Minneapolis, MN. In the fall of 1963, he was employed by Control Data for 27 years. This is where he met his wife Jane and were married in 1974. After Downsizing at CDC, he was employed by Ciprico in Plymouth, MN, for 10 years where he retired.

Darold enjoyed fishing and hunting with his son and his wife, along with cabin life on West Rush Lake near Rush City, MN.

Darold is survived by his wife, Jane, son, Nathan (Jamie) and granddaughter, Madeline, of Crystal, MN, brother Dwayne (Angie) of Pine City, MN, and many nieces and nephews. He is preceded in death by his father Gordon, mother

Margaret, sister Donna Kaufmann, sister Darleen Kurkowski, infant sister Marlys, and infant brother Regnold.
