David's work career was focused primarily in Purchasing & Materials Management including roles at Norton Company, Worcester, MA; Dennison Manufacturing Co., Framingham, MA; American Optical Corp., Putnam, CT; and, Northern Telecom Inc., Warwick, RI and Minnetonka, MN. David worked 13 years for Medtronic, Inc. in Minneapolis, MN and business travels took him to Puerto Rico and The Netherlands many times. David retired from Medtronic at age

65. David and Carol-Ann loved to travel visiting Ogunquit, ME, their most favorite place, many times over the years. Their children often spent time with them there also. They greatly enjoyed their Caribbean cruise, stopping at Puerto Rico and several other islands. They vacationed twice in exciting Las Vegas and three times in Florida.
