Age 87, passed away on Wednesday, March 25. He was preceded in death by his wife Ilona, "Lonni". Born in Mason City, Iowa, David grew up in Worthington, Minnesota, was active in scouting and debate, and graduated 7th in a class of 157. After graduating from the University of Minnesota, David and his wife, Lonnie, enjoyed 64 years of life together, calling Coon Rapids their home. David's professional career began as a systems analyst for Honeywell Aero before starting his own company, DSM Information Services, in 1980. David was also very active in the community, being a former Mayor, City Council Member, Charter Commission member and Planning Commission member in the City of Coon Rapids, Minnesota. David was the recipient of the Hubert H. Humphrey Institute Public leadership Award for Service as an Anoka County Commissioner and Chairman of the Metro Radio Board. As a member of the Coon Rapids Rotary Club, David served as President 2005-6 and received the Paul Harris Fellow award in 2004. In 1995, David began his flying career, earning private, instrument, and commercial certificates. In 2010, David flew with his son Kerry and grandson Connor to northern Alaska and back in a single-engine Cessna. David also wrote and published 2 books, "A Fair in Time" and "Gently Call and Softly Rise." His other hobbies included reading, playing bridge, traveling, woodworking, hunting and fishing.

David is survived by his children Kerry (Cathy) McCauley, Patrick McCauley (Janine), and Susan Schirmers (Brian), brothers George (Cindy) and Timothy (Karen), and grandchildren Bridget Schirmers, Megan Morris (Devon) Claire McCauley (Liam) and Connor McCauley (Lauren).

David's joy, hard work and leadership will be missed by everyone who knew him.

David's celebration of life will be held on April 28th from 3:00 - 6:00 at Washburn-McReavy in Coon Rapids.
