David Sohl Schneider, age 89, died September 29th, 2018, in his new home in Faribault, MN with wife, Esther, and family present. Dave was born on January 8th, 1929, in Kenyon, MN to Wesley and Huldah (Sohl) Schneider in Kenyon, MN. He was baptized on August 11th, 1929, in the Evangelical Church of Kenyon, MN. He graduated from Sleepy Eye High School; Westmar College, LeMars, IA; and from Evangelical Theological Seminary, Naperville, IL and was ordained for pastoral ministry in 1954. He served 38 years in five appointments in the MN Annual Conference of the United Methodist Church: Spring Valley and Preston; Faribault and Prairieville; West St. Paul; Rochester: Homestead; St. Anthony: Faith.

Dave served on various UM boards including Camping and Retreats

Ministries, Worship, the Board of Ordained Ministry, and Trustees. For many years he was chair of the Koronis Camp and Conference Center. More recently he and Esther enjoyed leading the Seniors Ministry of Centennial UMC, led worship for 17 years at Hts. Manor Residence, and participated in the Palestine-Israel Justice Project. He loved leading BWCAW canoe trips and was passionate in caring for the wilderness. Throughout his life he sought to share how Jesus the Carpenter of Galilee came to transform lives with God's love.
