Dean Ellis Heng, age 75 of Brooklyn Park, passed away at home on December 21, 2018 after battling cancer. He will be remembered as an artist for his watercolor, stained-glass, and wood-burning. He was drafted into the US Army in 1966 and served in Vietnam from 1967-1968. Dean was proud of the work he did as a landscape architect and maintenance manager for Hennepin County Parks from 1970-1999. He served as a Brooklyn Park City Councilman from 2009-2012. In July he celebrated 50 years of marriage to his loving wife Nancy. Dean was preceded in death by his parents, Oscar and Amy Heng; and brothers, Arthur and Owen. He will be missed by his loving wife, Nancy (Houseman) Heng; children, Steven (Mary Ellen) Heng and Karen (Todd) Olson; granddaughters, Danika and Kadrian Olson; mother-in-law, Lily Houseman; sister, Janet Holtz; brothers, Duane and Ray Heng; close friends, Harry and Carole Dixon; and other family, friends, and neighbors. 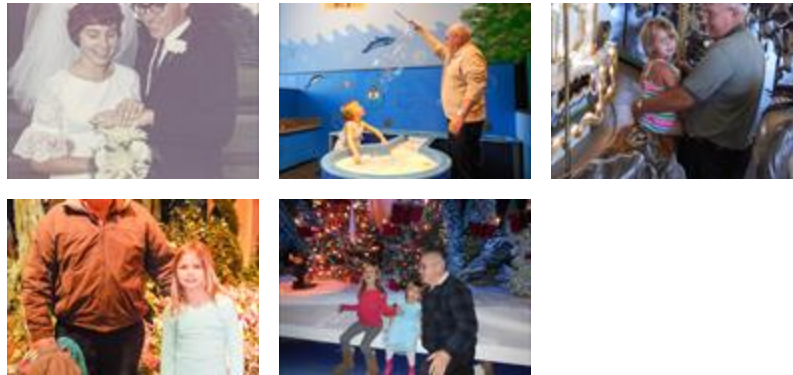
