Dennis Gordon Oberg, 82, entered his Heavenly home on April 26, 2025, in Eden Prairie, Minnesota, after a long battle with Parkinsons, surrounded by his loving wife of 51 years and his four children.

He grew up on a farm where he developed a strong work ethic and a deep love for God and his family. After graduating from Silver Bay High School, he attended the University of Minnesota

Duluth for two years and was then drafted by the U.S. Army, where he served for two years as a medic. Following the army, he worked in the airline industry at Northwest and Delta for over 40 years before retiring.

A loving husband to Kathy, Dennis was a pillar of strength and support for his family. He was a devoted father, always there to offer guidance, love, and make us laugh with his witty remarks. He cherished family gatherings, especially as his family grew to include grandchildren, and he participated in many backyard games and card games. He was never one to just "sit"; he wanted to play!

Even near the end of his illness, his youthful, fun-loving presence and love for others brought laughter to all who met him.

He is preceded in death by his parents and his granddaughter, Sophia. He is survived by his best friend and beloved wife, Kathy, his children: Nathan (Heather), Rebecca (Rob), Jessica, and Angela (Rob), and their 14 grandchildren.
