Dora Legg Herman, longtime Bloomington resident and prior resident of Minneapolis, Edina, Marco Island, FL, and Naples FL, died peacefully in Bloomington, MN on November 11, 2019 at the age of 99. Preceded in death by parents Harry G. and June (Welch) Legg, sister Pricilla Legg Struble, and husband Neil Bernard Herman. Survived by her children Robert (Karen) Herman of Edina, MN, and Ann (Galen) Johnson of Naples, FL, grandchildren Andrew Johnson, Kristen (Ryan) Bowlds, Alexander Herman and Sara Herman, and two great grandchildren. Dora won many amateur golf tournaments and was women's club champion at Edina and Minikahda a total of 5 years.

She graduated from West High School. She went to the University of Minnesota and was a member of the Alpha Phi sorority. She worked for Houghton Mifflin in Boston helping to finalize books for publishing. She was a polio survivor in 1952. She was on the Board of the Twin Cities Big Sisters Organization. She loved golfing, playing bridge, creating decorative purses,
