



Dora Zaidenweber

January 24, 1924 - September 21, 2023

Age 99, passed away peacefully in her home Sept. 21, 2023. Born in Radom, Poland, to Isaia and Hanna Rose Eiger, she survived the Holocaust along with her immediate family and immigrated to the U.S. in 1950. Despite never graduating high school due to the war, she earned a master's degree in economics from the University of Minnesota in 1952. She dedicated much of her life to Holocaust education, speaking about her experience in schools and communities across the Midwest. Preceded in death by her parents; her husband, Jules Zaidenweber; brothers Moniek and David Eiger, and sister-in-law, Barbara Eiger. Survived by her children, Rosanne Zaidenweber (Judy Levitan) and Gary Zaidenweber (Rachel Adelman); grandchildren, Etan Newman (Kashmir Kustanowitz), Tamar Goldblatt (Mat), Anat Naomi Zaidenweber, Jonah Krischer (Amy), and Gabriel Deacon; five adoring great-grandchildren who loved when she sang them "You Are My Sunshine"; nieces, nephews, and grand-nieces and -nephews.
