



## Doris Elaine Fallt

November 8, 1931 - October 29, 2023

Fallt, Doris Asplund McDill Doris Fallt, 91, went to be with the Lord on October 29th. She was born on November 8, 1931 to Walford and Esther Asplund on their farm near Wilton, North Dakota. Doris, a National Merit Scholar, graduated Bismarck High School in 1949. She went on to graduate from Trinity College in Chicago in 1951. Upon returning to her beloved North Dakota, Doris applied herself to building a career, and caring for her mother after her father's passing. Eventually, she became the Vice President of Administration of Knife River Mining, from which she retired in 1992 after 40 years. Doris flirted with marriage early, but didn't marry for the first time until 2002, when at age 70 she married Dr. Thomas McDill. After 14 years of joyful traveling through life together, Tom passed away. In 2020, Doris married, Reverend Robert Fallt after what Bob called a "Hallmark movie courtship." Thus began a new phase of life for the bride, aged 89 and the groom, aged 93. Throughout Doris' life, she committed her time and treasure to Christian ministries. She served on the Board of Regents for Trinity Evangelical Divinity School, a District Board of the Evangelical Free Church, Cooperstown Bible Camp, and Steer, Inc. Surviving are husband, Robert Fallt, his sons; Thomas Fallt (Cindy), David Fallt (Marlene), Philip Fallt (Dawn) and Maureen Fallt. Step daughters, Karen Carner-Lee (Mark), Jane Schultz (Bruce), Step son, Steven McDill (Joi) and many step grandchildren, and cousins. Doris had many cousins whom she spoke of affectionately. Their shared life experiences and commitment to Christ knit the Asplund cousins together in strong ties of
