Doris Mae Strand, age 85 of Hutchinson, MN died suddenly May 23, 2019 of an aneurysm.

Doris was born May 13, 1934 in Genessee Twsp, Atwater, MN to parents, Adolph and Leona (Thomas) Peterson. She was baptized July 29th at Immanuel Lutheran Church, Atwater. She was confirmed in her faith March 21st, 1948 in Svea Lutheran Church, Svea, MN. She graduated from Norwood Central High School in 1952, and attended on year at Mankato State University.
