Stumpf, Dorothy Lorraine (nee Dainsberg) Age 84, of St. Louis Park. Born in Delano on February 1, 1924, Dorothy was the daughter of Ole and Minnie Dainsberg. Throughout her life she was known affectionately by her middle name, Lorraine. Upon graduation from Delano High School, she joined the U.S. Navy serving as a Wave during WWII. She married George Stumpf of Medina in 1948 and worked for several years as a secretary for Brown and Bigelow. In 1952 they bought a house in St. Louis Park, where she resided with George until 2006, when she entered Colonial Acres Care Center in Golden Valley. She passed away on April 5, 2008. She was preceded in death by her parents, daughter, and sisters, Adele Carlson and Eleanor Nyberg; and brothers, Stanley and Harold. She is survived by her husband, George, to whom she was married for 59 years; her adopted son, Scott Stumpf Coltrane (Gloria); her brothers, Jack and Marshal "Bud" (Mardell); her cousin, Vi Clark; also many nieces and nephews, three grandchildren and three great-grandchildren. Lorraine was a caring, compassionate woman throughout her life who made friends easily and took special care to befriend and serve the elderly.
