



## Douglas William Burt

February 12, 1948 - April 15, 2020

It is with profound sadness that we announce the passing of Douglas W. Burt, age 72, of North Oaks, Minnesota, on April 15, 2020. Doug died after a courageous battle with acute myeloid leukemia. A beloved husband, father, grandfather, and a man of great intellectual curiosity and deep faith, Doug will be remembered for his devotion to his family and his thoughtful, courageous spirit.

Doug was born in Lincoln, Nebraska, on February 12, 1948. He graduated Phi Beta Kappa from University of Nebraska-Lincoln with a B.A. in mathematics in 1970 and from State University of New York at Binghamton with an M.A. in mathematics in 1975. Doug worked for over 40 years as a computer software engineer for IBM, Sperry, and SWAT Solutions, from which he retired in 2012.

Doug leaves behind a brokenhearted yet resilient family: loving wife, Lisa Hayes-Burt; children, Kathleen Burt, Erin Secord (Tom), Daniel Burt, Patrick Burt, and Heather Valone (Curtis); grandchildren, Claire, Benjamin, and Adam Secord; and many beloved family and friends.
