



Douglas Sweet

November 25, 1935 - January 8, 2025

Douglas Frederick Sweet went home to the arms of his Savior on January 8, 2025. Doug was born in Minneapolis on November 25, 1935. He was 89.

Doug spent his early childhood in Minneapolis, followed by 5 years in California where his father was stationed during WWII. After his family returned to Minnesota in 1946, Doug grew up in Golden Valley. Doug married the love of his life, Ann, in 1958 and remained happily married to her until her death in 2008. Doug began work at the family manufacturing business, FMS Corporation, in 1958 where he was employed for 43 years, serving 30 years as the company's president, until his retirement in 1998.

The most important thing in Doug's life was his faith and his personal relationship with his Savior, Jesus Christ. Doug and Ann shared a love for Jesus together, and in turn they shared that love with countless acquaintances, friends, and family over their 50-year marriage. Their trips to India together in the 1990s eventually led Doug and Ann to help organize an orphanage, Sweet Children's Centre, which still ministers today to the orphaned children of India. Doug was a member of Redeemer Bible Church for 57 years, where he served as an elder for more than 40 years.

Doug is preceded in death by his loving wife Ann and his parents, Fred and June. He is survived by his brother Gerry (LeAnn), his 3 sons, Greg (Janet),

Mike (Trisha), and John (Paula), and his 16 grandchildren and great grandchildren. He will be deeply missed, but we rejoice in the knowledge that his was a life well-lived, and he is now together with his Savior and his wife.
