Meisel, The Rev. Dr. Donald Morrison age 85, of Minneapolis. He was born in St. Paul, May 15, 1923. He was preceded in death by his wife, Eleanor Williams Meisel. Their children include: Donald M. He served on the Boards of Councils of Macalester College, Presbyterian Homes, Abbott Northwestern Hospital, The United Way, The Minnesota Orchestra, The Presbyterian Board of Pensions, The Greater Minneapolis Council of Churches, The Downtown Council, The David Preus Council, among others. He was co-founder of the Westminster Town Hall Forum and its moderator, 1980-1992. He was a member of Rotary Club No. 9, the Skylight Club, the Minneapolis and Minikahda Clubs.
