Ide, Dr. Arthur W., Jr. - Of Golden Valley Age 85 Died June 26, 2003 after a prolonged illness. Born in Brainerd, he graduated from St. Paul Academy, Dartmouth College and the University of Michigan Medical School. At the University of Minnesota Medical School, he received an M.S. in surgery. He was a captain in the Army Medical Corps and served as battalion surgeon in Europe during World War II. He practiced surgery in Minneapolis at Park Nicollet from 1951 until his retirement in 1992. He was chief of staff at Eitel Hospital and president of the Minneapolis Surgical Society as well as a member of the Minnesota Surgical Society. He was much loved by his patients and the nurses and doctors with whom he worked. Always athletic, he was playing his favorite game of tennis at age 82 when he collapsed and was ultimately diagnosed with pulmonary fibrosis. He loved sailing, skiing, travel and his cabin on Star Island. He leaves behind a devoted family--his wife of 52 years, Nadine; 2 sons, Arthur W. III, M.D. (Lisa), J. Warner (Carey); 2 daughters, Genet Duke (Ed) and Kiki Ide (Donald Austin); and 13 grandchildren. There will be a memorial visitation at WASHBURN-MCREAVY EDINA CHAPEL, W. 50th St. & Vernon Ave, at Hwy 100, Edina on Monday, June 30, between 5-7PM and a memorial service on Tuesday, July 1 at the CATHEDRAL OF ST.
