Age 86, of Saint Paul. Beloved and respected Professor Emeritus of English at Hamline University, from 1963-1993. Born March 4, 1928 in Indian Head, North Carolina, the son of a Methodist minister. Received his Bachelor's and Master's degrees from Duke University and his PhD from the University of Pennsylvania. Chaired the English Department before becoming the Director of Graduate Liberal Studies and supporting the Creative Writing program.
