Maus, DuWayne G. age 85 of Mpls, MN passed away on July 19. Preceded in death by parents, brother Kenneth, sisters Inez Rasmussen, Marilyn Blegen, Dulis Marcotte and Gwendolyn Maus. He is survived by wife Lorraine of 59 years, son Brian (Jodi) and daughter Laurie (Rich) Kastner, Grandchildren Justin (Emily) Nelson, Brandon Nelson, Sam Kastner, Becky (Nate) Titus , Shelley (Tom) Kotarski, sister Constance Dufour, sister-in-law Ruth Maus, three great grandchildren Zander, Gracie and Drake and many nieces and nephews. DuWayne was born in Cleveland, N.D. on May 24, 1929. He grew up in the small SW Minnesota town of Arco, and then moved to Minneapolis at the age of 13. He attended Roosevelt High School, graduating in 1947. DuWayne joined the Naval Reserves, and served on active duty aboard the Battleship Iowa (BB-61) in Korea. After being discharged, he married Lorraine Bandzak in 1955. They first lived in Richfield, then moved to South Minneapolis. DuWayne was the proud father of Brian Wayne (1958) and Laurie Ann (1962), building many school projects with them. He was a first-rate wood craftsman, car refinisher and electronics experimenter. DuWayne also loved spending time at his cabin on Big Pelican Lake near Brainerd where he would fish, hunt and spend time with his family. He especially enjoyed hunting with his brother Ken. DuWayne worked for 32 years at Western Electric Co. (AT&T), first as a teletype repairman and then as a quality analyst. He later worked as a custodian at the U. of M. main campus for 12 years before retiring. After retiring, DuWayne enjoyed taking long walks

around Lake Nokomis. He spent his final days at The Alton memory care in St. Paul, where he passed away on July 19, 2014.
