Edith Della (Erlander) Freddo of Minneapolis, MN passed away on Thursday, May 31, 2018 at her residence at the Park Health and Rehabilitation Center nursing facility following an undiagnosed health issue. She was 63. Born on April 20, 1955, “Eadie” – as her friends and family called her – was a lifelong avid bowler and employed by Apple Place Bowl in Apple Valley, MN.
