Edmond Stanley Subject "Fast Eddy" of Robbinsdale, age 81, returned to the Heavenly Father on Monday July 21st, 2025.

Ed was known for his dedication, loyalty, generosity, quick-wit, and service, He bravely battled cancer while staying in touch with those who served alongside him.

Ed was born on June 11, 1944, in Minneapolis MN. He graduated from Patrick Henry High School. Drafted into the US Army in Sept 1966. Ed was assigned to Baumholder, Germany and was attached to the 8th infantry division as an E5.

Ed attended the University of Minnesota in 1962 and played for the MN Gopher football team. In 1964 Ed attended Minnesota State University-Mankato, continued his football career as a split wideout and safety. He also played for the first Mankato Hockey team.

In 1971, Ed pursued a career in law enforcement and retired from the Minneapolis Police Department in 1992. Ed continued his law enforcement career with Dayton, Rogers, Corcoran and the Metro Transit Police Departments and completed 42 years of service.

Ed cherished quiet days at the cabin, lively games of cribbage, cruising in his favorite cars, sharing heartfelt stories, spoiling his daughter's dogs, and always had a sweet treat close at hand.

Ed was preceded in death by his parents Edmond Stanley Subject Sr. & Kathleen, brother George, and sister Barb. He is survived by his loving wife

Janet (58 years of marriage) his daughter Katie (Dustin), son Tom (Mimi), along with four grandchildren Allison (Weston), Jack (Jess), AK, Will and one great grandchild Miles, as well as his brother Richard (Pam) and many nieces and nephews.

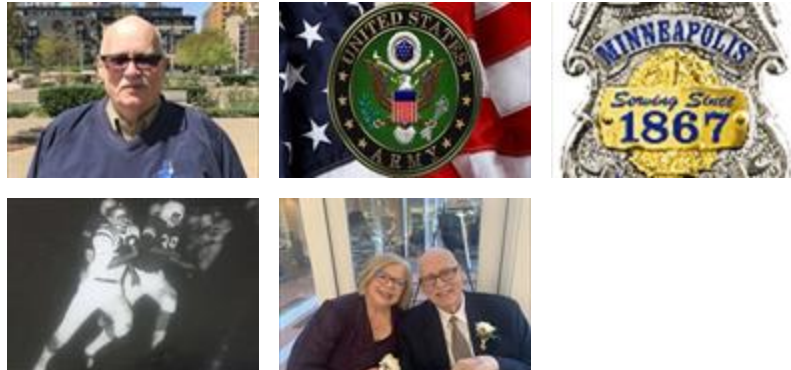
