Chrencik, Edward W. Age 92, of Saint Louis Park, passed away on Thursday, February 5, 2015. He was one of five children born of immigrant Czechoslovakian parents in Osage, Iowa, on August 16, 1922. Funeral services will be held at Washburn-McReavy Hopkins Chapel on Monday, February 9, at 3:00pm. Visitation will be held at the funeral chapel one hour prior to the service. Ed married his wife, Dorothy, in 1953. He attended the U of Iowa School of Engineering College in Cedar Rapids, Iowa, and received a degree from the Illinois College of Podiatry in 1950. As a podiatric surgeon, he made many lasting contributions to the field of podiatry throughout his career. He held a pilot's license for 65 years and owned 15 different land and sea planes. He is a World War II Air Force Veteran. Ed was gifted with many hobbies including hunting, fishing, flying, woodworking, gardening, cooking, dealing cars at auctions, driving his John Deere tractor, and storytelling.
