Wiik Edward M. Wiik, age 88, of Mpls, on July 5, 2003. Preceded in death by sister, Mary Peterson of CA. Survived by wife, Wanda; sons, John (Susan) of Shoreview, Jim (Dianne) of Taylors Falls; granddaughters, Katherine Wiik of Cambridge, MA and Kristen Wiik of Shoreview; also 1 nephew, 3 nieces. Ed's military service included Air Service Command duty during WWII in the South Pacific and 24 years, USAR, from which he retired as a Lieutenant Colonel. Ed earned a degree in Mechanical Engineering from the University of MN in 1939 and was a licensed professional engineer. He later earned a Master's of Public Health from the U of M. During his career, Ed helped establish the air pollution control programs for the City of Minneapolis and the State of Minnesota. He retired from the State of Minnesota as Director of Air Quality for the Pollution Control Agency.
