Pennock, Elizabeth Hultgren (Jevne) Dancer and Philanthropist passes away at 92 Jevne Pennock passed away Thursday, she was born March 13, 1913 in Minot, North Dakota. She moved to St. Paul at a young age where she began a dancing career while attending St. Paul Central. She attended the University of Minnesota and was a member of Alpha Gamma Delta sorority, The University Singers, and the Garrick Club. She was part of "June & Jevne" and "Williams & Jevne" who performed throughout the region dancing. She married George Tennant Pennock in 1945 and devoted her life to her husband, children, and numerous civic and cultural activities in the community. She served on Boards at Abbott Northwestern Hospital, The Minnesota Opera Company, YWCA, University of Minnesota Foundation, and the Children's Home Society. She was a member of AAUW, Interlachen Country Club, The Minneapolis Athletic Club, The Minneapolis Club, and Westminster Presbyterian Church. Following the death of their daughter Molly, she and George endowed a chair in Diabetes Research at the University of Minnesota School of Medicine. Jevne is survived by her sister Virginia Kohl of Minneapolis; son and daughter-in-law, David & Diane Pennock, Edwards, Colorado; and grandchildren George & Richele Pennock, Miami, Florida, Dr. Andrew & Paige Pennock, San Diego, California, and Kevin and Jevne Bennett of Edina.
