Elroy Eugene Madsen, (WWII veteran - medic in the Philippines) died peacefully in the hospice ward at the VA Medical Center December 19th, 2022. He is survived by Lucy (Madsen) Segesky and her husband Michael Segesky; preceded in death by Alta Mae Madsen and Karen Madsen. Elroy enjoyed independent living until October 11th, when he was hospitalized for a collapsed lung. He made a valiant effort to recover, but after decades of conquering COPD, CHF, a clogged carotid artery, and other health issues, his time on earth ended. Elroy was a hardworking man as he supported a family of four on an 8th grade education as "body man" (fixed up cars). Elroy enjoyed golfing, bowling, feeding all the fish at his daughter's therapy clinic, delivering newspapers at his condo, and spending time with friends, neighbors, and his "surrogate" grandkids. Elroy was a loving husband, father, uncle, and friend to many. No matter how he was feeling, when people asked: "How are you doing?" Elroy answered: "Fantastic!" He also remembered something special about each person he met. His dry sense of humor was spectacular. Elroy was truly an amazing man and one of a kind!
