Born October 17, 1933 to Bernard and Magdalene (Plocharz) in Gilman, MN. Ervin grew up on the family farm and after graduating from high school, enlisted in the United States Marines. He served three years in the Marines first as an MP in Puerto Rico before a 22 month deployment in Korea. He earned the Distinguished Service Medal and Good Conduct Service Medal, Meritorious Sergeant and platoon leader, and recognition and several medals from the South Korean government including an Ambassador for Peace award.

Ervin dedicated his time to numerous veterans organizations. He was a member of MN Korean War Vets Chapter 1 where he was their First Vice President, Kraus Hartig VFW where he was a member of their honor guard for many years, 70 year member of the American Legion, Metro Marines, instrumental in forming the Honor Guard at Epiphany Catholic Church, A.M. Vets of Florida and a member of the Anoka Veterans council.

Ervin worked at May Brothers for over 39 years never missing a day of work. A long time active member of Epiphany Catholic Church, Ervin was a Eucharistic minister and usher.
