Ethel Mae (Heglie) Henderson of St. Anthony, MN, passed away on February 16, 2021. Ethel was born on a farm near Walcott, ND on April 5, 1921, graduated from Pleasant Consolidated High School, and completed her education at St. Luke's School of Nursing, becoming a registered nurse in June 1943.

Ethel married Daniel John Henderson on December 14, 1945 and they had four children, although their son Dennis died as an infant. Ethel worked as an RN at the Fargo Clinic, specializing in diabetic education. She continued to live in Fargo after Daniel's death in 1988 until moving to the Minneapolis area to live with her daughter, Diane, in 1993.
