Eugene Michael "Mike" Bush of Falcon Heights passed away on February 26, 2025 at the age of 80 years. Born August 8, 1944 in St. Paul, Mike grew up in NE Minneapolis and attended John Marshall High School. From 1962 to 1966 he served in the US Naval Air Corps and served aboard the USS Ticonderoga CVA-14.

Throughout his career as a documentation specialist, Mike wrote a variety of technical manuals, but his true professional love was photography. Mike was the consummate traveler, always in a quest to discover beauty through the lens of his camera. Through his business, Adventure Photos, Mike won numerous local and national awards. He displayed his photos throughout the Twin Cities. His photographs were also shown on A & E's World of Photography and numerous other TV programs.

In his younger years, Mike also loved racing his 1967 Camaro and his 1969 Corvette. His love of sports cars was a constant throughout his life.

But more than cars and photography, Mike loved his family and friends. He shared his love of camping with his daughters through their yearly camping trip to Itasca State Park. He leaves behind his wife of 16 years Rochelle Christensen, his two daughters Breanna Sturgesleski and Amanda Natzel, his four grandchildren Ella, Odin, Marlowe, and Liam, and his brother, Joseph

Bush. Mike was preceded in death by his mother, Virginia Griffith, and his sister, Donna Ringness.

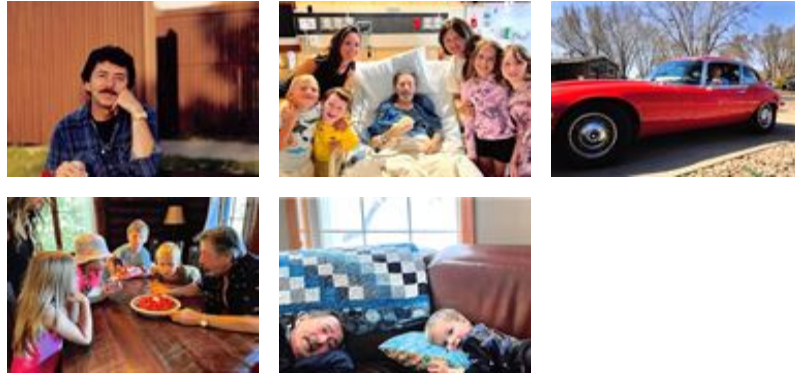
