July 6, 1933 - June 14, 2022

On June 14, 2022, Gene Clemens passed on to join his beloved wife, Jacquie, in the comfort of their Lord. Gene was a devoted husband, father, grandfather, great grandfather, Veteran of the Korean Conflict, a faithful servant of his church, a dedicated member of the VFW Honor Guard, and longtime supporter of the Boy Scouts of America.

Gene was born July 6, 1933. He attended Blackburn College and took his engineering degree to Motorola and then Honeywell, where he spent the rest of his working life. He was proud of his career and carved out a fine living for his wife, and two sons. Having successfully kicked them from the nest, he and Jacquie spent many of the next years enjoying the grandchildren and providing much love and care as the families grew up.

Along the way Gene enjoyed many connections to the community, including time with The Bach Society, Ham radio club (KB0MIP), SkyWarn, The Bloomington Chorale, and a life long investment in the Boy Scouts of America. Of special meaning to Gene was his time with St. Marks church. Gene loved his church family and spent many hours working the newsletter, audio visuals for services and whatever else needed doing.

Late in life Gene devoted his energy to the care of Jacquie as she was slowly taken from him by Alzheimer's. Despite her failing health, Gene kept her as

his constant companion at community and family events. He provided daily care until she was called home June 12, 2019.

Gene will be forever remembered by all as a selfless man who wished for nothing in return as he gave so much. He is preceded in death by brother Rodney (Jane) and survived by brother James (Jean), sons Jeff (Joy), Chris (Leah), Grandchildren Krista, Jeff Jr. (Deidra), Kaitlin, Whitney, Heather, and Erin, Great Grandchildren Abi, Ari, and Hudson Gene Clemens, born just hours before his passing.
