



## Eugene T Lundquist

February 20, 1947 - July 15, 2015

Age 68 of St. Paul Born on Feb. 20, 1947, in Chicago, Illinois, and died on July 15, 2015, in St. Paul, Minnesota. He graduated from Alexander Ramsey High School where he sang bass in the concert choir. He held a variety of jobs, the longest of which was in assembly at the Arden Fastener Company. He was a talented photographer and took many fine pictures of city skylines and interesting buildings. Gene was a caring person who had a good sense of humor and enjoyed jokes and funny stories. He served for several years as president of the Third Floor Resident Council at Maplewood Care Center where he lived for six years. He had many good friends among the residents. their wonderful care of Gene, particularly Chris, Ardetta, Jodie, Aschalew, Alphonse and many others. They truly made him feel "at home" there.
