Frank and Ellen Steinhorst As a young girl, she spent most of her growing up
years in Dunnell Minnesota. She attended the Country School District 69. She
completed the 8th grade before she devoted her time on the family farm.
Some of her first jobs included working as a nanny and working for the candy
shop in Fairmont Minnesota. On May 13th, 1941, she married Raymond
Frisbie at the parsonage in Ceylon Minnesota. She and Ray owned and
operated the State Line Store south of Fairmont for 16 years. In 1954 she and
Ray lost an infant daughter shortly after childbirth. In 1958 she had a son
(Kevin) born in the Fairmont Hospital. Around 1960 they moved to
Minneapolis Minnesota. For most of Kevin's younger years she worked in their
home in Fridley Minnesota doing child care and ironing. In February 1971 she
lost her husband Ray to a heart attack. She worked for Ault incorporated for
20 ½ years doing soldering, electrical windings and as a supervisor before
retiring. Later she worked for Arby's restaurant and as a greeter at Walmart.
Evelyn was a member of the Fridley United Methodist Church since 1963.
Evelyn was active for many years in a bowling league, card clubs and she
loved to camp and fish. Evelyn is survived by her son Kevin, his wife Paula,
and five grandchildren: Katherine, Tara, Michael, Michelle and Steven, and
two sisters Mildred (Norman) Woods, Ruth (George) Winslow and a brother
Richard (Darlene) Steinhorst. She is also survived by a host of extended

family and friends. Preceded in death by her parents, brother Donald and an infant grandchild, Jamie M.
