Harloff, Gary L. 67, passed away from pancreatic cancer in Charleston, SC on October 17, 2017. Gary was born in Minneapolis on July 3, 1950 and attended Washburn High School. In 1968, Gary joined the U.S. Marine Corps where he proudly held the rank of corporal. Gary served his country for four years, including from 1968 to 1969 when he was stationed in Vietnam. He received a purple heart and was honorably discharged from the U.S. Marine Corps in 1970. Gary worked in retail before entering into the car business where he worked for over 25 years as a manager. The joy of Gary's life was his wife of 37 years, Mary Jo, and their three sons. The boys recall that Gary never missed one of their sporting events, and there were many. Prior to moving to South Carolina in 2008, Gary and Mary Jo made their home in Annandale, MN. Family time was always a priority and shortly before he passed away, Gary enjoyed visits with all his children, including his three grandchildren. His mother, Geraldine Johnson and stepfather Al Johnson predeceased Gary. He is survived by his wife, Mary Jo, his three sons Brad Harloff (Justin) of Annandale, MN, Scott Harloff (Brandi) of Grand Forks, ND, Steve Harloff (Mia) of Severn, MD as well as three grandchildren, Griffen, Rowan and Easton Harloff. His three sisters, Judy Dubois, Pam Lind and Becky Hines and a niece and many nephews also survive him. There will be a private family viewing on Wednesday, November 1 at Washburn-McReavy in Edina at 11am.
