Flannery, George P. age 87, of Mpls. George was born in Mpls on Sept. 30, 1922, the son of Henry C. & Marcia B. Flannery. He outlived his parents; his wife, Anne, of 52 years; his brother, Henry and sister, Leslie Brooks. He was on the board of directors of the Legal Aid Society for several years. George, being a firm believer in a college education, established the George & Anne Flannery Scholarship Program at Annandale High School in Annandale, MN near Lake Sylvia, where he and Anne, family and friends enjoyed many summers. George was past president of the Minikahda Club, he co-authored the Minikahda Club 50-Year History. He was a founder and perpetual president of the Rutabaga Institute.
